How to Get Here

The Irish National Heritage Park is located 5.5km outside Wexford Town in the southeast corner of Ireland.

Shuttle Bus

A shuttle bus between Ferrycarrig campsite, Redmond Square (Wexford Town) and the Heritage Park will operate every morning and € evening for €3.80 return. Shuttle bus tickets are available HERE.

Tickets must be purchased up to 48 hours in advance of each journey (so that EBUKI can book the right sized bus). Once purchased, tickets are non-refundable.

By Plane

Dublin Airport

The nearest airport is Dublin Airport, 160km from the Irish National Heritage Park and approximately 13/4 hours by car.

As Ireland's largest international airport, Dublin Airport is extremely well connected to every corner of the globe. Numerous low-cost air operate out of Dublin.
